Members of the Knights of Columbus participating agree to comply with the rules of the United States Bowling Congress and the Tournament Rules of the Wisconsin Knights of Columbus Bowling Committee.

REGULATIONS

1. Scratch bowling will be from 210 average. Over 210 average bowls scratch. Handicap will be based on 100% of the difference between 210 and the actual average. Highest average from the 2008/2009 season; if none for the last year, use two years ago.
2. Individual averages must be based on a sanctioned league average with a minimum of 21 games. If there is no average for the two (2) previous seasons and a current average has been established for 21 or more games as of entry closing date, use the current average. If the highest current average for 21 games or more as of entry closing date is fifteen (15) pins or more than average determined above, current average must be used (per Tournament Committee). We do not require the reporting of previous prize winnings.
3. Attention is called to Rule 319a-3. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his average in handicap or classified tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler, his team captain or others. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than actual average.
4. An entrant is obligated to submit himself for re-rating if within the past 12 months he has accumulated an average in 21 or more games of tournament play which exceeds the average to be used by 15 or more pins (Rule 319-e).
5. If a person does not have an average as stated above, he will be given a 150 average for handicap purposes, but if this person has bowled in the Wisconsin K of C Tournament in any one of the past 3 or all 3 years, then his tournament average will be used. These averages will be kept on file with the State of Wisconsin K of C Bowling Tournament Committee.
6. A maximum handicap of 80 pins per man per game will be allowed.
7. Entry fee is \$16.50 per man, per event. Bowling cost is included in fee.
8. A bowler is permitted to enter only once in each event except as follows: Host council may re-enter on non-hosting teams as many times as needed to ensure full lineups. A host council bowler may compete more than once in the Team, Doubles and Singles events providing he is substituting for an original entrant in these events. Not more than three bowlers on the same team can place more than once in the prize list for position standings. When a host council competes more than once, his first appearance in each event shall count towards his all events score (USBC Rule 315). A bowler may collect only one prize in any event, handicap or scratch, whichever is higher.
9. Substitutes not to exceed three men are allowed in the team event. In the doubles event, one scheduled person must bowl. In the singles the absent bowler will receive no score.
10. Names should be printed plainly to avoid error in schedule, score books, etc.
11. Entries close December 15, 2009, however all entries postmarked the first Post Office business day after entry closing date will be accepted. No record of entries until money is received (USBC Rule 310a).
12. After any entry fee has been received and filed, the entry fee in no case will be refunded.
13. Bowlers are asked to be ready to bowl when it is their turn. This will ensure that your fellow bowlers will be able to begin their scheduled shift on time.
14. All bowlers must check in 30 minutes before time scheduled to bowl.
15. USBC moral support certified provides high score recognition of USBC members participating while permitting non-USBC members to compete in certified competition. Eligible non-USBC members desiring the USBC recognition awards may purchase an associate membership card prior to bowling. Only entrants who have established USBC membership prior to participation shall be qualified for USBC High Score Recognition.
