



WISCONSIN KNIGHTS of COLUMBUS CAMPERS ASSOCIATION GUIDELINES

1. This association shall be known as the “Wisconsin Knights of Columbus Campers Association”.
2. Annual dues for membership in the association will be \$5.00 per family. The male head of the family must be a member in good standing of the Knights of Columbus. Dues are payable upon registration at the camping weekend or by mail to our Secretary/Treasurer. If unable to attend the camping weekend, mail your dues to keep your name on our membership list. Note: All members who owe TWO years of back dues will have their names moved to the inactive list and will not receive information on upcoming camping weekends.
3. Widows of deceased members of the association will remain members of the association free of charge. At any time, widows can ask to have their names removed off our mailing list.
4. The association will consist of the following structure of officers:

President	1 Year Director
Vice President	2 Year Director
Secretary/Treasurer	3 Year Director
Historian	Host Committee Chairman
State Officer - Appointed by the State Deputy	
State Camping Coordinator - Appointed by the State Deputy	
5. An officer must be a member in good standing, or a spouse of a member of the Knights of Columbus.
6. The camping weekend shall be the weekend following Father’s Day in June.
7. An Officers Meeting will be held at the request of the President each year during the camping weekend prior to the annual general meeting.
8. The general meeting of the association will be held on Saturday. The time and location will be posted at the registration table.
9. The annual election of officers shall take place at the general meeting as the first new business of the meeting. Nominations for the elective officers shall be made by a nominating committee, appointed by the board. Nominations from the floor will be accepted for any of the offices.
10. Bids for camping weekends: Any member or group of members can put in a bid to host a camping weekend TWO YEARS hence. This bid is to be put in at the general meeting of the association. They must have general information on the campground, type of facilities offered, rates, etc.
11. The general membership will vote on all bids for camping weekends at the annual general meeting.
12. Host Committee will coordinate their plans with the officers of the association and the State Camping Coordinator.
13. In the case of NO bid for the next year’s camping weekend at the general meeting, the officers (our board) will undertake the task to oversee getting a site and committee to run the next year’s camping weekend by November 1st plus mailings in November or December with general information to the membership.
