The dates were chosen to be early enough to give students in religious education classes an opportunity to participate, and to avoid spring break and Easter.

Feel free to change *anything* as needed. This is strictly a local project; there are no additional layers of judging. Winners do not advance. The idea here is to give you an easy to run project that results in guests at one of your summer meetings. If you give out a prize for every grade, you double your guests, and your opportunity to recruit.

As for prizes, you are free to do whatever you want. For example, one Council gave all entrants a prayer card, and the first place winners received an additional \$15 Culvers gift certificate that was awarded at their summer cookout where the winners and their families were invited as guests.
